

## Editorial

In the course of 1974, some members of the Editorial Board resigned, mainly because their age was preventing full participation. We give them our best thanks for the help they have given over the years. Three members have been lost by death: Dr. Jaroslav Kramářík CSc., Prague, died on 1. 3. 74 at the age of 51. As an outstanding expert in Czech and Slovak folk culture, particularly in the field of agrarian ergology, he belonged to the Editorial Board from its inception. Dr. Harald Hvarfner, Stockholm, died on 17. 1. 75 at the age of 48. He was the director of the Nordiska Museum, and a leader in the development of museum techniques. He was appointed to the Editorial Board in 1974. Prof. Dr. K. Rob. V. Wikman, Åbo, died on 14. 5. 1975 at the age of 89. This grand old man of Nordic and European ethnology belonged to the Editorial Board from its inception.

We welcome as new members Tamás Hofer, Leopold Kretzenbacher and Ernesto Veiga de Oliveira.

The principle of adopting a general theme for each issue will be continued. The theme of acculturation, which is prominent in the present issue, will certainly be taken up again in the future. For forthcoming issues, there will be contributions that will look at Europe as a whole, a discussion of the structuralist concept and of the theme of migrant labour and trade. Reports on the current research situation in different regions, and methodological contributions, will continue to be published.

Ten years after the foundation of the Ethnologia Europaea group, we may again emphasise the aim which was stated then:

To unite all those who are anxious to devote their knowledge and efforts to the progress not only of European but also of general ethnology.
